

TIME, DESIGNED:

CSI Fresno's 3rd Annual Student Design Competition

Your Mission: To design and construct a functioning, standing clock inspired by an Architect, Engineer, Designer or structure.

The clocks will be on display for industry professionals at the 2019 CSI Product Show on Thursday, April 11th, where attendees will cast their vote for the the most successful timepiece.

The winning clock designer will received a \$500 cash prize.

Contest entrants will also have the opportunity to participate in a silent auction for their clocks, with compensation from the auction going directly to the student.

Design Assignment:

Pick an Architect, Engineer, Designer or structure of your choice and design a free-standing clock inspired by that Architect, Engineer, Designer, or structure. Clock design must meet the minimum design constraints as listed below. Provide **two copies** of a separate presentation board with the required information listed under "Design Constraints."

Attendees at the CSI Fresno Products Show will vote for their favorite clock. The CSI Fresno Board Members will evaluate each submission on theme and craftsmanship. The submission with the highest combined score of evaluation points and popular votes will be announced as the competition winner, and will be presented with a **\$500** prize from the CSI Fresno Chapter. All participants also have the option to participate in a silent auction. Attendees will be allowed to place bids on the clocks accompanied with a silent auction bid form. The silent auction sale value of sold items will go directly to the participant who created the clock.

Deadline to register as a participant: **April 4, 2019** by **4:00pm**. Participant spots are limited, so please register soon!

Student Competition Rules:

Participant must be currently registered as a student and must show valid Student ID upon submitting your clock and presentation boards.

Clocks may be located throughout the circulation path of the showroom along with one copy of your presentation board. A second copy of your presentation board will be located centrally in the designated Poster Display Area.

Participant has the option to include their clock in a silent auction, however this is not required.

Design Constraints:

Clock:

- Clock must be no larger than 12" tall x 12" wide x 12" deep.
- A total of three materials must be used (this does not include the clock mechanism or fasteners)
- Clock must be a standing clock (not meant as a wall hanging clock) so that it can be displayed on a table top.
- No power will be provided for clock displays. It is recommended to have any electronics powered by battery.

Presentation Board:

- Provide TWO COPIES of your presentation board
- Presentation boards must be 11"x17" mounted on 3/16" foam backing
- Presentation boards must include Participant's Name, Participant's School, Participant's Major, Photo of Participant's clock, Example of work that inspired clock design, a list of the three materials used, and a brief statement explaining the design concept.

Attendee Voting:

Attendees will be given a voting token at the registration table upon signing in at the CSI Products Show. Attendees will use this voting token to vote on their favorite clock. Votes will be cast by placing their voting tokens in a container next to the displayed clock of their choice. Each attendee will only be given one voting token. All voting must be done prior to the end of the CSI Products Show on **April 11, 2019**. Anyone is welcome to attend the CSI Products Show and participants are encouraged to invite their friends, family, classmates, etc. Remember, all attendees get to vote.

If you plan to stay for the CSI Products Show, Please pre-register as an attendee to speed up the check-in process and ensure we have enough voting tokens for all attendees. Attendees can pre-register for the CSI Products Show at www.csifresno.org.

Grand Prize Winner:

The participant with the highest combined score of evaluation points and popular votes will be chosen as the grand prize winner of the Student Design Competition. Participants will be scored 1 point for every vote received at the CSI Products Show. All entries will be evaluated and ranked by the CSI Fresno Board based on theme and craftsmanship. Participants will receive one point for their entry and each entry they out rank.

Example: If a participant is receives 1st place rank out of 10 entries, they will receive a total of 10 points. A participant ranked 10th out of 10 entries will receive 1 point.

The Grand Prize Winner is scheduled to be announced within one week of the CSI Products Show on our Facebook Page (www.facebook.com/CSIFresno). Make sure to like our Facebook Page for updates. The Grand Prize winner will receive a check for \$500 from the CSI Fresno Chapter.

Optional Silent Auction:

Participants may opt in to participate in the silent auction of their clock. To participate in the silent auction, a silent auction bid form must be completed and turned in with your clock. On the Silent Auction Bid Form, please provide an original title for your clock, fill in your name, provide a brief physical description of your clock, and set the minimum starting bid. Participation in the silent auction does not guarantee your clock will be sold. In the event that your clock is sold, the full sale price of your clock will be paid to you. Participants are fully responsible for contacting silent auction bid winners in the event payment is not received at the end of the CSI Products Show. Silent auction bids will close at **7:00pm** on **April 11, 2019** and winning bidders will be announced.

If winning bidders are not present at the close of the silent auction, Participants are responsible for contacting the bidder via their contact information listed on the bid sheets.

Set up:

Participants can submit their clocks and presentation boards beginning at **12:00pm** on **April 11, 2019**. Any submissions received after **4:00pm** may be deemed ineligible. Please include a Silent Auction Bid Form with your submission if you would like to participate in the optional silent auction. Any participants who bring submissions but have not registered as a participant in the Student Design Competition by the registration deadline, may be deemed ineligible and their submissions may be refused.
